

Maestro Gregory Woodbridge



Gregory Woodbridge begins his tenure as Music Director of the Hershey Symphony Orchestra this season, which will include three Masterworks and three Pops Concerts. He also holds the position of Associate Conductor of the Harrisburg Symphony Orchestra and Music Director/Conductor of the Harrisburg Symphony Youth Orchestra (HSYO). He continues to inspire impassioned performances from orchestras at all levels, student through professional, and has been praised for his exceptional musicianship and artistry on the podium.

Maestro Woodbridge began studying piano at the age of seven and violin at the age of nine. He holds degrees from Penn State University, and furthered his conducting studies with Michael Jinbo (the Pierre Monteux Conducting Institute in Maine); Leonid Korchmar (Kirov Opera and St. Petersburg Conservatory); Ennio Nicotra (founder of the Ilya Musin Society); and Gustav Meier and JoAnn Falletta at the Conductor's Institute Richmond Symphony Masterclass.

Maestro Woodbridge was previously Music Director and Conductor of the Central PA Youth Orchestra, the Wednesday Club Youth Orchestra, the Central Pennsylvania Symphony and the York Youth Symphony Orchestra. In addition to having served as guest conductor for the Hershey Symphony for five years, other previous conducting engagements include, York Symphony (PA), the PMEA Region IV-V State Orchestra Festival, the Lebanon Valley College-Community Orchestra, the Messiah College Orchestra, and return engagements with the Hershey Symphony at Mt. Gretna's Summer Theatre Series. He has also led the Harrisburg Symphony on their Masterworks and Pops Series. Maestro Woodbridge lives in Mechanicsburg, PA with his wife Heather and their two children, Delaney and Liam.

He is honored to serve as the new music director and conductor for the Hershey Symphony and continue this extraordinary 55-year tradition.

Michael Cavanaugh



Michael Cavanaugh is the new voice of the American Rock & Roll Songbook and a charismatic performer and musician made famous for his piano/lead vocals in the Broadway musical Movin' Out. Handpicked by Billy Joel to star in Movin' Out, Cavanaugh evokes a style rivaling the Piano Man. He appeared in the show for three years with over 1,200 performances and received multiple accolades. The show culminated in 2003 with both Grammy and Tony award nominations.

Michael began playing at age seven, when his parents bought their first piano. Encouraged by family and friends, and inspired by his hero Billy Joel, Michael formed his first band at age 10 and began playing local functions, fine-tuning the craft that would become his chosen career.

With the close of *Movin' Out* at the end of 2005, Michael began touring in his own right, creating a show that reinterprets the modern pop/rock songbook. Michael soon became one of the hottest artists in the private events market, and he continues to perform worldwide for company and charity events as well as sporting events including many PGA tour events, the SuperBowl, and the Indy 500. His interpretation of the modern rock/pop songbook led to *Billboard* calling him "The New Voice of the American Rock and Roll Songbook," and he was recognized by Reuters as *Entertainer of the Year* for the private events market.

It wasn't long before symphony orchestras discovered Michael's talents and audience appeal. He accepted his first orchestral booking, "Michael Cavanaugh – The Songs of Billy Joel and More," which debuted in April 2008 with the Indianapolis Symphony and continues to tour today. In October 2008, he signed with Warner/ADA to distribute his first CD, *In Color*. In June 2010, Michael debuted his second symphony show in the *Generations of Rock* series titled "Michael Cavanaugh: The Songs of Elton John and More" and then debuted his third symphony show, "Singers and Songwriters: the Music of Paul Simon, Neil Diamond and James Taylor," in 2012. In 2015, he debuted his fourth symphony show: "Rockin' Christmas with the Pops." He continues to tour all four symphony productions along with performing with his band in performing arts centers and other public venues.

The Hershey Symphony Foundation

The Hershey Symphony Orchestra Foundation was established to ensure the long-term future of the Symphony. Established as a supporting foundation in 1988, it receives, holds, and invests permanent gifts in an endowment fund, with on-going distributions that directly benefit the Hershey Symphony Orchestra. Governed by a board of directors made up of members of the community and the orchestra, it depends upon the support of friends like you who treasure the innovation and artistic excellence of the Hershey Symphony Orchestra.

Gifts to the Foundation provide long-term support to the Orchestra. In addition to making cash gifts, planned gifts can be made in a variety of ways, including beneficiary designations for your retirement plan, life insurance, investment accounts, or remembering the Hershey Symphony Orchestra in your will or living trust. Qualified retirement plans, such as traditional Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs) and 40l(k) plans, may be the most tax-efficient way to make a planned gift to the Foundation. These assets have never been taxed and, as a charitable organization, the Foundation would not have to pay any taxes on a gift from a retirement plan. Gifts of appreciated securities are another tax-efficient donation in which the Foundation receives the full market value of the securities. The donor claims the same amount on their tax return and avoids the capital gains assessment on a future sale. Lastly, if you are 70½ or older, you can instruct your IRA custodian to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). QCDs can fulfill some or all of your annual required minimum distribution. They are excluded from taxable income, but they do not produce a charitable contribution deduction.




